<u>Matthew 18:15-17</u> supposed to confront someone who wrongs me, with gentleness, and the goal of restoration. I should follow Matthew 18:15-17.
<u>1 Peter 5:5b-11</u> 1 Peter 5 says, "God opposes the"
The Greek word for "opposes" could be translated "To set!" It means to resist.
1 Peter 5 says, "God to humble people."
When God lifts me up, after I humble myself, he does so with his hand!
Satan wants me to be and angry. I must remember that taking offense probably means I'm too
If we humble ourselves, and resist the temptation to lash out against those who do us wrong, then God will:
me ( <u>mend</u> /care for) - make me
ONLINE: I should humble myself and avoid posting anything expressing anonymous, or against someone else to hash out personal problems. If I must post, it should be things.
REAL LIFE: I should not " the matter" but offer forgiveness. I also need to , considering other people as good as me, especially in the most difficult
circumstances, so God will lift me up.
