### Bible Verses: Genesis 6-9

God decided to \_\_\_\_\_ mankind, and that's what we deserved.

God had \_\_\_\_\_ on Noah, and Noah \_\_\_\_\_ God.

Humans \_\_\_\_\_, and God promises to save Noah anyway!

#### Genesis 3:15

In Genesis, God \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ Satan's head; i.e. \_\_\_\_\_ mankind and doom Satan. Mankind screws up, *but* God promises to save those who \_\_\_\_\_ anyway!

After the flood, God makes a \_\_\_\_\_ to every living thing: I will never cut off all life by waters of a flood again.

Right after judgment... God \_\_\_\_\_ (or promises) to save all mankind from that \_\_\_\_\_ of judgment again.

**The Bible guarantees that God will have \_\_\_\_\_ one more final judgment!!!**

But God has made a covenant of \_\_\_\_\_ to us through \_\_\_\_\_.

Matthew 26:26-28: Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ is a *covenant*, from God to us, promising \_\_\_\_\_ if we accept forgiveness and know Jesus.

WE SCREW UP OFTEN – But God promises to save and \_\_\_\_\_ us if we \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus.

Romans 5:20: Jesus' blood has so perfectly covered our sin that \_\_\_\_\_ can stop it!

#### Romans 5:20,6:1-4

As part of the covenant, Jesus gives us \_\_\_\_\_! We \_\_\_\_\_ to that old way of living.

**Jesus will not leave us:** that should compel us to \_\_\_\_\_ God \_\_\_\_\_ - not sin!

**Practical application 1:** I do not need to \_\_\_\_\_ about whether or not God is going to judge me, unless I have not made a \_\_\_\_\_ decision to be a follower of Jesus and ask for forgiveness.

**Practical application 2:** If I have decided to be Jesus' follower, I must be completely committed to following him, and not in some half-way lazy \_\_\_\_\_ way either. A thorough giving of myself to him, because there is \_\_\_\_\_ in knowing my savior.
