Proverbs 28:26

He who trusts in himself is a fool, but he who walks in wisdom is kept safe.

Fixing problems \_\_\_\_\_ doesn't always work out!

Problem: there is a \_\_\_\_\_ to human wisdom. We do not know the \_\_\_\_\_ to every problem.

Daniel focuses on two things to obtain the wisdom he needs:

**TRUTH ABOUT HOW GOD GIVES WISDOM:**

- God gives wisdom \_\_\_\_\_.
