### Verses: Matthew 13:1-23

#### Galatians 5:22-24

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

The \_\_\_\_\_ the Spirit (found in Galatians 5) are the types of things you would see in someone living a truly \_\_\_\_\_.

This is clear: peace, love, joy cannot be obtained \_\_\_\_\_ apart from the Spirit of \_\_\_\_\_.

#### Matthew 13:19

Option 1: Someone who \_\_\_\_\_ the message but does not \_\_\_\_\_ it.

#### Verses 20-21

The seed on rocky soil with no roots "falls away." That is the Greek word *skandalizo* and it literally means, to be \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_. It is where we get the word scandalized from.

#### 2 Timothy 3:12

In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted,

#### Romans 14:19

"Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification."
