**Two themes in Mark 5:21-4**

- 1) God, through Christ, \_\_\_\_\_ from our shame.
- 2) The \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus in the act of redemption.

Jairus was willing to \_\_\_\_\_ in the synagogue of falling at the feet \_\_\_\_\_.

Jairus' daughter was suffering the \_\_\_\_\_, dying, at 12 years old.

Even after he is informed his daughter \_\_\_\_\_, Jairus puts his hope in Jesus (not caring what shame others might put on him for thinking a \_\_\_\_\_).

The woman suffered the shame and pain of \_\_\_\_\_, both.

Jesus says that *the women's FAITH* (trust in Jesus) healed her; she was \_\_\_\_\_.

Jairus' willingness to accept the shame or ostracization of being with Jesus results in his daughter being \_\_\_\_\_! And nobody can take that away from him. His daughter lives and his \_\_\_\_\_ is removed.

**Practical Application:**

I can \_\_\_\_\_, regardless of what shame I'm feeling. It doesn't matter what my friends, family, or others think God \_\_\_\_\_ if I believe.
